


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Risk Management Graduation Model (RMGM)

- Comprehensive best practice framework tailored to MFIs at different tier levels of development
- Set of standard guidelines for types of polies, limits, risk management & monitoring tools MFIs should have in place
- Considers the financial and social dimensions of risk
- Assessment Tool allows users to measure adherence to RMGM framework and pro-actively strategize for future

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




Risk Management Graduation Model Assessment

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Industry Recommendations

- Focus on developing a culture of risk within MFIs. Its not only about seeking to manage credit, operational, and financial risks through having the right policies and tools in place, but also developing a culture of doing the right thing in the absence of formalized risk management systems.
- To avoid future crises, MFIs need to prioritize risk management and be prepared to get their hands dirty.
- MFIs and investors need to undertake a perspective shift from short-term to longterm.
- Regulators can use the Risk Management Graduation Model as a tool to develop new, and improve existing, risk management regulation as the framework provides clarity around practical ways MFIs can structure their risk management function.



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
