


# The Financial Inclusion Compass 2023: Reflections with CGAP on the Present and Future of Inclusive Finance




- Began in 2018; 2023 is sixth *Compass* edition
- Mixed-methodology survey various stakeholder groups' perceptions of sector trends, future priority areas, challenges and opportunities
- 2023: 185 total respondents from 58 countries
- S1: score importance of 20 *current* trends on 1-10 scale
  and optional comments
- S2: rank top five subjectively of 15 Future Priority Areas – and optional comments
- S3: rotating open-ended questions: in 2023: Challenges and opportunities; legacy of the pandemic; and future avenues of research





Compass respondents by organization type




Local or regional association



World clouds of challenges & opportunities, legacy of the pandemic, and future research avenues









#### Some selected themes to kick off discussion

- Green and climate smart finance as *de facto* theme of the 2023 survey
  - …in present trends, FPAs, and challenges & opportunities
- Increasing importance of gender mainstreaming within FSPs, recognition that pandemic widened certain gender gaps, and enormous work to be done on gender equity
  - O Probably understates the actual importance (see 'gender bonds, etc.') pushing 'new financial instruments' from 20<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup>)
- Client protection overlapping with DFS now, are these topics inseparable? Concerns about implications of AI on CP
- Threats to household resilience, external factors, cost of living, climate and inflation are major concerns
- Client-centricity and focus beyond access and usage to financial health, mentioned more and more
- Serving FDPs/refugees a huge emerging challenge
- Increased research focus should be on AI opportunities, household resilience, delivery of NFS and implications and impact of climate change on vulnerable segments
