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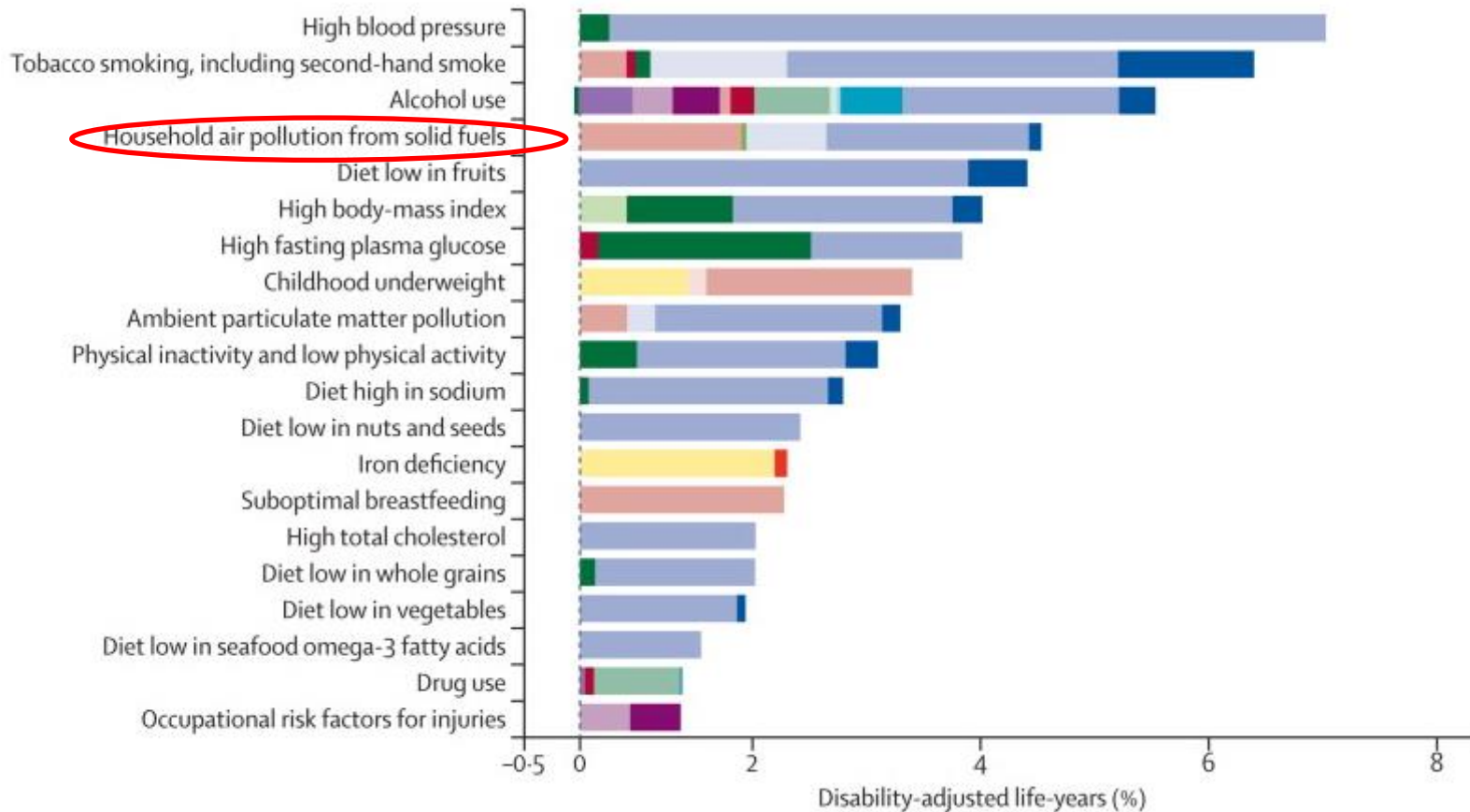
Energy situation in developing countries	Developing countries	Sub-Saharan Africa

1.5 billion lack access to electricity	28%	>70%

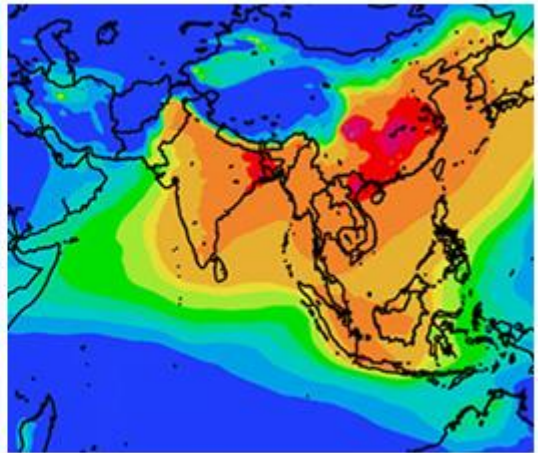
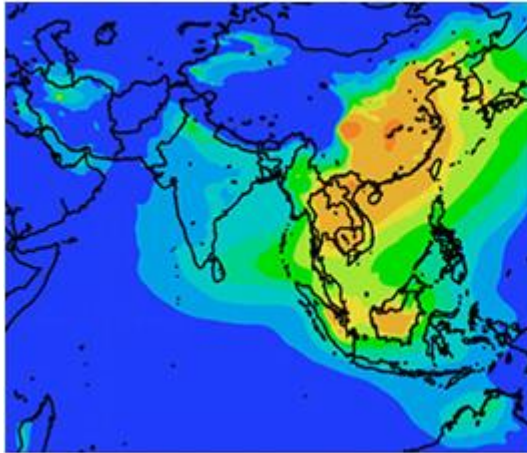


Burden of disease attributable to 20 leading risk factors in 2010. Lim et al, 2012
